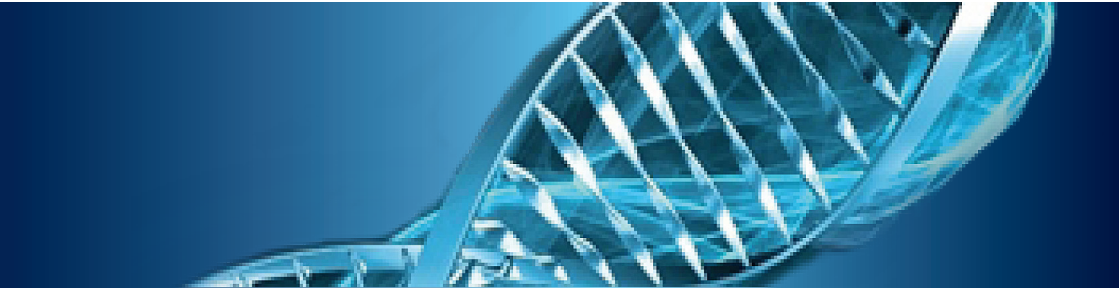

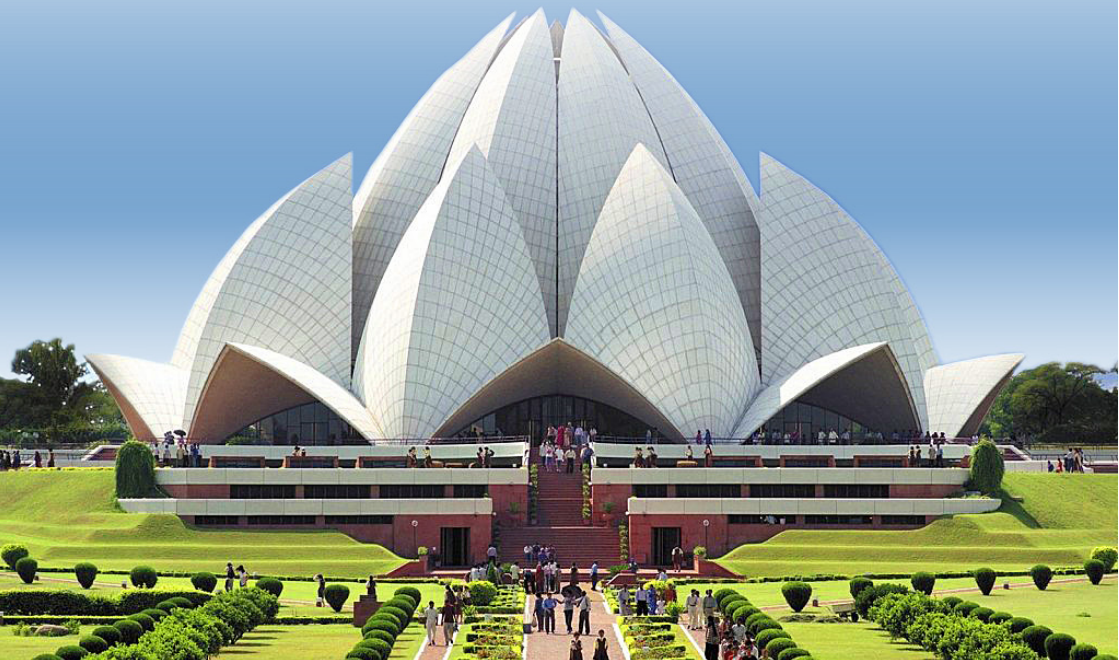

ABOUT THE CONFERENCE

Abstracts are invited for presentation as a poster or as a podium talk. All abstracts should be based on original research related to the topics of relevance to the conference and should be submitted via email at conference2012@carcinogenesis.net until **15 January 2012**.

FORMAT FOR ABSTRACTS

- Abstract should not exceed more than 500 words.
- To be typed in font size-12 (Times New Roman) in double space.
- The authors should provide their postal address, e-mail and fax number
- The organizing committee reserves the rights for accepting/rejecting the abstract.
